Data Management Plan vs. Data Governance Plan

DATA MANAGEMENT PLAN



- Outlines the specific processes and technical details for handling data
- Focusing on how to collect, store, and access data
- The HOW of data handling

DATA GOVERNANCE PLAN



- Establishes the policies, standards, and guidelines for how data should be used/managed
- Ensuring its quality, security, and compliance with regulations
- The "WHAT" and "WHY" behind data management practices

- Supports transparency and credibility






